To Our Courageous AGC Community,

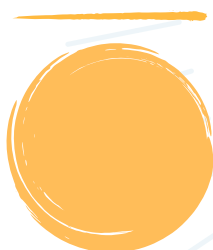
With your help, All God's Children has participated in the creation, mending, and growth of the most powerful influence in the world: FAMILIES. That is our mission, and your commitment has made it possible.

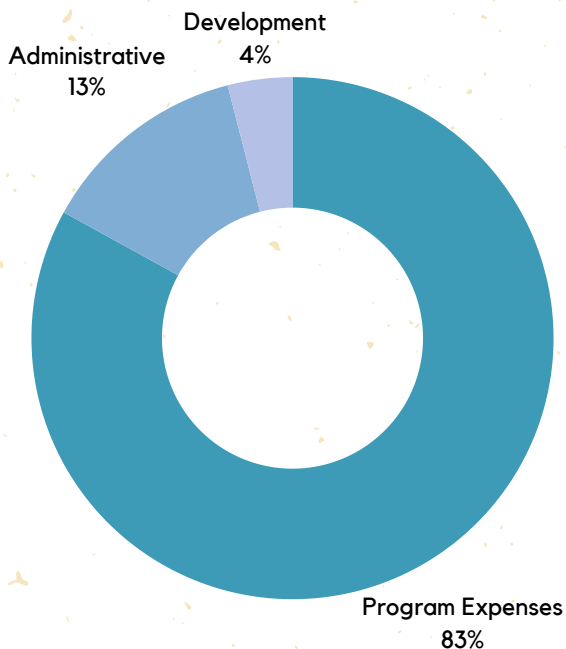
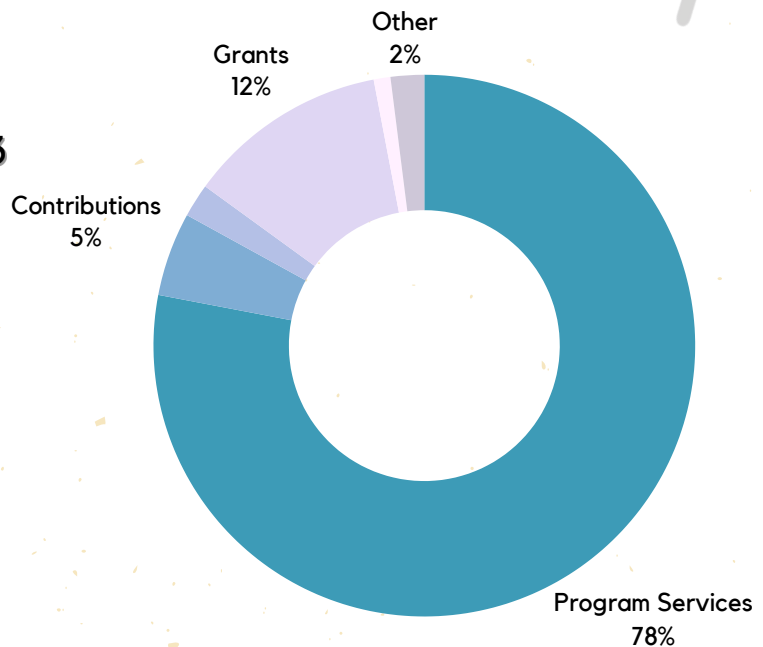
