Greetings from the Executive Director

Usually I take the opportunity in the newsletter to update our supporters and friends on the numbers we have served, babies born, girls graduated, etc.....and I realize most people want to hear those facts. However, AGC could not have all those great outcomes without an incredible staff behind the scenes. In each upcoming newsletter I would like to feature one of the AGC departments.

Since we are a Treatment Agency, we could not exist without our Treatment Team which serves both the group home and foster homes. This last year we have seen an explosion in the need for pregnant and parenting services. Typically we may average around 6-8 teen moms at a time for the year; this year we have averaged 12-13 teen

moms at any given time. Last night I had our weekly parenting support group which includes teen moms from the group home and foster homes. We had 15 teen moms attending the parenting session with an additional 14 year old about to deliver her first child. So please allow me to introduce our great treatment staff and please remember them in prayer as you pray for AGC. They all could be making a ton more money elsewhere but have chosen to serve with us.

Carolyn Wilkinson, LCSW has been Treatment Director since we opened in 1999. She is a true friend and has taught me so much in the field of mental health.

Our two therapists have been lifesavers in more ways than oneand they both have newborns of their own.
