God's light is shining bright on AGC. We are excited to announce the addition of our **Therapeutic Foster Care Program**. These services are custom-designed to meet the needs of at-risk, teenage mothers and their children. Residents at All God's Children have stabilized their behaviors and improved their mental health. However, they are still young moms of infants and toddlers who have limited parenting skills and limited support systems.

With the option of having a transitional system in place within the AGC foster care program, youth and their children from all over the state can experience a loving, committed foster home while continually working on the skills necessary to be a positive and successful parent. Additionally, if temporary separation of teenage mother and child is necessary, foster homes can be a quick solution for placement of a child until/if reunification with the mother can occur.

Since this program has been in effect, AGC has begun training multiple foster families and three children have already been placed in safe and loving homes. The next training opportunity for families will be in March 2013.
